A training package is comprised of



Units of Competency

A work function

Are building blocks for skill sets and qualifications

Example: Install and repair fences and gates unit of competency



Skills Sets

A specialist industry need or regulatory/licence requirement

Made up of 3-7 Units provide potential pathway towards a qualification

Example: Recognise Aboriginal Cultural Sites Skill Set



Qualifications

A job role

Total of 15-30 Units

Example: Certificate III in Agriculture (Dairy Production)

Training Packages are used in



Registered Training Organisations

Formal training and assessment



Workplaces

Informal on-the-job learning and assessment
