Lengthy consultation in the tree felling units with the Forest Works Project found the AHC Arborists reject that this unit be a part of the Core units as they do not have trees to fell in urban Arboriculture. In particular for assessment that they do not have adequate trees to assess as an arborist.

The role of the arborist in this job of tree felling is a dismantle mainly and a final fall of a tree using ropes and other equipment. The Arborists felt this unit would be better placed as an elective so arborists can choose to add this if required. I move to effect this unit to change to the Group F General Electives.
