Approx. 2-7 units, can provide potential pathway towards a qualification Example: AHCSS00160 Recognise Aboriginal Cultural Sites Skill Set





Qualifications

A job role

Approx. 13-30 units

Example: AHC30122 Certificate III in Agriculture (Dairy Production)
