NSW Skills List Additions Proposal Process Now Open

The NSW Skills List identifies the vocational education and training (VET) qualifications eligible for a government subsidy under Smart and Skilled. The list is reviewed annually to ensure it meets the changing skills needs of industry.

You are invited to propose a qualification to add to the NSW Skills List. The Skills List Review is an evidence-driven process and the Department relies on stakeholders to clearly demonstrate the value of qualifications to NSW employers and students. The criteria used to assess qualifications for inclusion and/or removal from the NSW Skills List is outlined in the [Skills List Management Policy](#).

Before completing a proposal for an addition, please ensure that the proposed qualification is not already on the list by viewing the current [NSW Skills List and the Pre-qualified List](#), which identifies qualifications eligible for faster re-addition to the Skills List.

It is strongly recommended that stakeholders provide a range of evidence to support applications including data, letters of supports, reports or survey results. Skills Insight JSC holds some enrolment and employment data and may have other data and knowledge of government strategies.
