Job role	SSAPP14 Packer / Dispatch Officer
Job role description	Prepares finished garments and apparel products for storage, distribution and shipment within textile, clothing and footwear manufacturing environments. The role ensures products are packed, labelled and dispatched accurately according to customer, retailer or distribution requirements. Packer / Dispatch Officers coordinate with warehouse, logistics and production teams to ensure timely dispatch of finished goods and accurate documentation of shipments.
Performance expectations	• Accurately pack garments and apparel products for shipment • Ensure correct labelling, tagging and packaging standards • Prepare dispatch documentation and shipping labels • Maintain product quality during packing and handling • Meet dispatch deadlines and shipment schedules • Maintain accurate records of outgoing goods • Support inventory accuracy during packing and dispatch • Maintain clean and organised packing and dispatch areas
Specialisation	Garment packing and presentation, retail order preparation, bulk shipment preparation and logistics documentation for apparel distribution.
Application in other TCF sectors	The skills described in this profile are transferable across multiple sectors of the textile, clothing and footwear (TCF) industry and may also be applied in other manufacturing and product-based industries where similar capabilities are required.

Key tasks	• Pack finished garments according to customer or retailer requirements • Prepare cartons, packaging materials and shipping labels • Verify order accuracy before dispatch • Coordinate dispatch schedules with warehouse and logistics teams • Record dispatch details in inventory or warehouse systems • Inspect garments for damage prior to packing • Prepare export or shipping documentation • Maintain packing materials and dispatch equipment
Critical work functions	• Ensuring correct and timely dispatch of finished products • Maintaining product quality and presentation during packing • Supporting efficient warehouse and logistics operations

	• Preventing shipment errors and dispatch delays • Maintaining accurate shipment documentation • Supporting customer and retailer delivery requirements

Garment packing procedures	Pack garments according to retailer and logistics specifications.
Product identification	Identify garment styles, sizes and product codes accurately.
Dispatch documentation	Prepare shipping labels, manifests and dispatch records.
Inventory systems	Record outgoing goods in warehouse management systems.
Packaging standards	Apply appropriate packing materials and carton preparation.
Barcode scanning	Use barcode scanners and tracking systems.
Quality inspection	Check garments for damage or defects prior to packing.
Workplace safety	Follow WHS procedures when handling goods and equipment.
