Job role	SSAPP24 Sewing Technician / Machinist - Apparel
Job role description	Constructs garments using industrial sewing machines and specialised equipment in cut and sewn apparel manufacturing. The Sewing Technician / Machinist joins garment components such as panels, sleeves, collars and pockets according to production specifications and quality standards. The role requires precision sewing skills, knowledge of garment construction and the ability to operate a range of industrial sewing machines.
Performance expectations	• Operate industrial sewing machines safely and efficiently • Construct garments according to technical specifications and patterns • Maintain consistent seam quality and garment construction standards • Handle fabrics and garment components carefully to avoid damage • Identify and report sewing defects or material faults • Maintain production output targets • Follow workplace safety procedures and equipment guidelines • Maintain clean and organised workstations
Specialisation	Garment construction using industrial sewing equipment including lockstitch, overlock, coverstitch and specialised sewing machines.

Key tasks	• Prepare garment components for sewing operations • Operate industrial sewing machines to assemble garments • Sew seams, hems, pockets, collars and other garment components • Maintain consistent seam quality and alignment • Inspect garments during assembly to identify defects • Adjust machine settings for different fabrics and sewing tasks

Critical work functions	• Maintaining consistent garment construction quality • Ensuring accurate assembly of garment components • Preventing damage to fabrics and materials • Supporting efficient garment production workflows • Maintaining operator productivity and efficiency • Ensuring garments meet product specifications and quality standards

Garment construction techniques	Understand garment assembly and sewing methods.
Fabric handling	Handle different fabric types during sewing operations.
Machine adjustment	Adjust machine tension, stitch length and settings.
Quality inspection	Inspect seams and garments for defects.
Production workflow understanding	Understand garment assembly sequence in production.
Component alignment	Align garment panels and components accurately.
Workplace safety	Follow WHS procedures when operating sewing machinery.
