Job role	SSAPP26 Technical Designer / Garment Technician
Job role description	Translates garment design concepts into technically detailed specifications suitable for manufacturing. The Technical Designer / Garment Technician prepares technical packs, measurements, construction details and quality standards for apparel products including cut and sew garments and knitwear. The role works closely with designers, product developers, patternmakers and offshore manufacturers to ensure garments meet fit, quality and production requirements.
Performance expectations	• Prepare detailed technical packs and garment specifications • Define measurements, tolerances and construction standards • Collaborate with designers to ensure designs are technically feasible • Review samples and prototypes for construction and quality issues • Manage fit approvals and update technical documentation • Support communication with offshore manufacturers • Ensure garments meet brand quality standards • Maintain accurate product development documentation

Product development systems	Use PLM and product documentation systems.
Quality control knowledge	Identify construction and quality issues during development.
