Job role	SSAPP29 Digital Knitwear Programmer / Knit CAD Technician
Job role description	Develops and manages digital knitting programs used to produce knitwear garments on computerised knitting machines. The role involves translating design specifications into machine-readable knitting programs, testing knit structures, adjusting stitch parameters and supporting production teams operating advanced knitting equipment such as whole garment and seamless machines.
Performance expectations	• Develop knitting programs for computerised knitting machines • Translate garment design specifications into knit structures • Test and refine knitting programs to achieve correct garment construction • Collaborate with designers and production teams to optimise knitwear production • Ensure knitting programs deliver accurate sizing and garment shape • Support machine operators during production troubleshooting • Maintain digital records of knitwear programs and product specifications • Contribute to continuous improvement of knitwear manufacturing processes
