1. Job role

Job role	SSAPP30 Garment Dyeing Technician
Job role description	Operates and monitors dyeing processes used to colour finished knitwear garments. The role involves preparing dye baths, operating garment dyeing machines, monitoring temperature, chemical concentrations and dye uptake, and ensuring garments achieve consistent colour quality and fastness. Garment Dyeing Technicians work closely with textile technicians, quality inspectors and production teams to ensure dyed garments meet product specifications and brand standards.
Performance expectations	• Prepare dye formulations according to production specifications • Operate garment dyeing machines safely and efficiently • Monitor dye bath temperature, chemical levels and processing times • Ensure colour consistency and dye penetration across garments • Identify and correct dyeing faults or colour variation • Maintain safe handling of dyes and chemicals • Meet production schedules and dyeing batch targets • Maintain clean and compliant dyeing work areas
Specialisation	Garment dyeing, knitwear colour finishing, dye formulation, garment wash and dye processes, and colour consistency management for knitted garments.
Application in other TCF sectors	• Textile dyeing and finishing facilities processing fabrics • Apparel manufacturing operations using garment-dyed products • Technical textile finishing where colour treatments are applied • Textile processing industries requiring dye chemistry and colour control

2. Key tasks and critical work functions

Key tasks	• Prepare dye mixtures according to product specifications • Load garments into dyeing machines • Monitor dyeing cycles including temperature, time and agitation • Test colour samples during dyeing processes • Rinse, wash and finish dyed garments • Inspect garments for colour consistency
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	• Maintain dyeing equipment and work areas • Record dyeing batch data and production information
Critical work functions	• Achieving consistent colour across garment batches • Maintaining accurate dye formulations and chemical handling • Ensuring garments meet colour and quality standards • Preventing colour variation and dyeing defects • Supporting efficient textile finishing operations • Ensuring environmental and chemical safety compliance

Garment dyeing machine operation	Operate garment dyeing machines and control processing cycles.
Dye chemistry knowledge	Understand dye types, chemical reactions and colour formulation.
Colour matching	Monitor colour results and adjust dye processes.
Temperature and process control	Control temperature and time parameters during dyeing.
Fabric and fibre knowledge	Understand dye behaviour across different fibres.
Quality inspection	Identify dyeing faults such as uneven colour or staining.
Process documentation	Record dye batches and production parameters.
Workplace safety	Follow WHS and chemical handling procedures.
