Job role	SSAPP38 Heat Transfer / Heat Seal Operator - Apparel
Job role description	Applies heat transfer graphics, vinyl, labels and heat-sealed components to garments and textile products using heat press and sealing equipment to meet design specifications, production requirements and quality standards. In apparel production—particularly in sportswear, uniforms and branded garments—the Heat Transfer / Heat Seal Operator prepares materials, positions designs, operates heat press systems and ensures durable, high-quality application. The role supports both bulk production and customised, short-run manufacturing.
Performance expectations	- Producing transfers that meet design specifications and durability standards - Maintaining consistency in placement, adhesion and finish - Operating heat press and sealing equipment efficiently and safely - Preparing garments and materials correctly for application - Minimising defects such as misalignment, peeling or scorching - Meeting production targets and timelines - Ensuring correct temperature, pressure and timing settings - Maintaining equipment performance and reporting faults - Following workplace safety and operational procedures - Supporting efficient production workflow and customisation processes
Specialisation	Vinyl heat transfer, sublimation transfer, heat sealing, label application, reflective and technical transfers
