Job role	SSAPP8 Fit Coordinator / Fittings Coordinator
Job role description	Coordinates garment fit evaluation during the apparel product development process. The Fit Coordinator organises fit sessions, manages fit models and records technical feedback used to refine garment patterns and specifications. The role works closely with designers, technical designers, patternmakers, product developers and sample machinists to ensure garments achieve the intended fit, proportions and comfort before production approval.
Performance expectations	• Organise and coordinate garment fit sessions • Prepare samples and documentation for fittings • Record detailed fit comments and technical observations • Coordinate communication between technical teams and suppliers • Maintain fit standards across garment size ranges • Manage fit models and measurement records • Track garment revisions following fit reviews • Support product approval prior to production
Specialisation	Garment fit evaluation and coordination of fittings during product development.

Key tasks	• Schedule and coordinate garment fit sessions • Prepare garments and documentation for fittings • Record fit observations and technical comments • Communicate fit feedback to patternmakers and developers • Maintain garment measurement and fit records • Coordinate revisions to patterns and samples • Track fit approval through development stages • Maintain fit standards for product categories
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Critical work functions	- Ensuring garments achieve correct fit and proportions - Supporting collaboration between design and technical teams - Maintaining consistent fit standards across product ranges - Preventing fit issues before production - Ensuring accurate documentation of fit evaluations - Supporting efficient product development cycles

Fit evaluation techniques	Assess garment fit on live models or mannequins.
Garment construction knowledge	Understand garment structure and assembly.
Measurement analysis	Interpret garment measurements and size charts.
Fit documentation	Record detailed fit observations and technical comments.
Pattern awareness	Understand how pattern adjustments affect fit.
Sample evaluation	Review prototype garments during development.
Technical communication	Translate fit observations into technical instructions.
Product development systems	Maintain documentation in PLM or development systems.

Communication	Explain fit feedback clearly to development teams.
Collaboration	Work with designers, patternmakers and developers.
Organisation	Coordinate fit sessions and development timelines.
