1. Job role

Functional area	Finishing and Dispatch
Job role	SSAPP9 Garment Finisher
Job role description	Performs final finishing operations on garments in apparel manufacturing environments to ensure products meet required quality, presentation and customer specifications. The role includes removing loose threads, attaching labels and trims, inspecting garment quality, pressing or steaming garments where required and preparing finished garments for packing or dispatch. Garment Finishers work closely with sewing operators, quality control inspectors and packing staff to ensure garments meet production and retailer standards.
Performance expectations	• Ensure finished garments meet quality and presentation standards • Remove loose threads and minor defects from completed garments • Attach labels, tags or trims as required • Prepare garments for pressing, packing or dispatch • Identify and report garment defects or quality issues • Maintain consistent finishing standards across production batches • Meet production finishing targets and schedules • Maintain safe and organised finishing workstations
Specialisation	Garment trimming, final garment inspection, label attachment, thread trimming and preparation of garments for pressing, packing and dispatch.
Application in other TCF sectors	Transferable to other TCF industry sectors in which final finishing of product is required.

2. Key tasks and critical work functions

Key tasks	• Trim loose threads and clean finished garments • Attach labels, care tags and brand tags • Inspect garments for finishing defects • Prepare garments for pressing or steaming • Assist with folding and preparation for packing • Report garment defects or sewing issues • Handle garments carefully to avoid damage • Maintain finishing records where required
Critical work functions	• Ensuring garments meet required quality standards • Supporting efficient garment finishing operations

	• Maintaining consistent garment presentation • Preventing damaged or defective garments from entering dispatch • Supporting efficient production workflow • Maintaining product consistency for retailers and customers

Thread trimming techniques	Remove loose threads and excess stitching cleanly.
Garment inspection	Identify minor garment defects during finishing.
Label and tag attachment	Attach brand labels, swing tags and care labels.
Garment handling	Handle garments carefully to prevent creasing or damage.
Basic garment pressing support	Prepare garments for pressing and finishing.
Production workflow understanding	Understand garment manufacturing and finishing processes.
Quality awareness	Recognise quality requirements for finished garments.
Workplace safety	Apply WHS practices when handling equipment and garments.
