1. Job role

Functional area	Carpet Manufacturing Operations
Job role	SSCAR02 Production Operator – Backing / Coating Line
Job role description	Operates and monitors backing and coating lines that apply secondary backing materials and coatings (e.g. latex or polymer compounds) to tufted carpet to stabilise the structure and achieve required performance characteristics. In Australia's carpet manufacturing industry, this role is critical in converting tufted carpet into finished product by ensuring adhesion, dimensional stability, durability and finish quality. The operator manages coating application, curing processes and line speeds while maintaining consistent product quality. The role requires coordination with upstream tufting operations and downstream finishing processes, working within highly automated, continuous production environments where precision, timing and process control are essential.
Performance expectations	- Producing coated carpet that meets specification and performance standards - Maintaining consistent coating weight, adhesion and coverage - Operating coating and curing equipment safely and efficiently - Minimising defects such as delamination, uneven coating or curing faults - Monitoring line performance and responding to process variations - Maintaining continuous production flow and throughput - Recording production and quality data accurately - Following WHS, environmental and process control procedures
Specialisation	Latex backing, polyurethane coating, multi-layer backing systems, carpet tile backing, high-speed continuous coating lines, and artificial grass [synthetic turf].
Application in other sectors	- Synthetic turf production (coating and backing processes) - Textile finishing and coating operations - Industrial textiles with coated substrates - Automotive flooring and interior materials - Composite material production

Key tasks	• Setting up backing and coating line parameters • Preparing and mixing coating compounds • Feeding tufted carpet into coating line • Monitoring coating application and curing processes • Adjusting line speed, temperature and application rates • Inspecting coated carpet for defects • Recording process and production data • Cleaning and maintaining coating equipment
Critical work functions	• Ensuring consistent coating application and adhesion • Maintaining curing conditions for product stability • Preventing defects such as delamination or uneven backing • Maintaining synchronisation between line components • Supporting efficient material usage and waste reduction • Ensuring safe handling of chemicals and equipment • Delivering consistent output for downstream finishing
