Job role	SSCAR003 Production Operator – Finishing
Job role description	Operates and monitors finishing processes that prepare coated carpet for final use, including trimming, shearing, inspection, rolling, cutting and packaging. In Australia's carpet manufacturing industry, the Production Operator – Finishing ensures that carpet products meet final quality, dimensional and presentation standards before distribution. The role involves working with automated finishing lines and inspection systems to identify defects, ensure consistency and prepare products for dispatch. The operator works closely with upstream tufting and backing/coating operations, ensuring that finished products meet customer and regulatory requirements while maintaining efficiency in high-volume production environments.
Performance expectations	- Producing finished carpet that meets quality and presentation standards - Ensuring accurate cutting, trimming and rolling - Identifying and removing defective product - Operating finishing equipment safely and efficiently - Maintaining consistent output and throughput - Minimising waste and rework - Recording production and inspection data - Following WHS and operational procedures
Specialisation	Carpet tile finishing, broadloom rolling and cutting, automated inspection systems, edge trimming and shearing processes. Finishing processes in artificial grass [synthetic turf] manufacturing.
