Job role description	Maintains and services installed synthetic turf systems to ensure ongoing performance, safety and durability in sports, commercial and recreational environments. In the synthetic turf sector, the SSCAR19 Synthetic Turf Maintenance Technician is responsible for inspecting, cleaning, repairing and restoring turf surfaces in accordance with industry standards and manufacturer specifications. This includes maintaining infill levels, surface integrity, drainage performance and playability characteristics. The role supports asset longevity and compliance with performance standards (e.g. FIFA, World Rugby, local standards) and works closely with facility managers, installers and testing technicians to ensure surfaces remain safe and fit for purpose.
