Functional area	Clothing Alterations and Repairs
Job role	SSALT6 Dressmaker
Job role description	Constructs, alters and repairs garments for individual clients. Responsible for garment pattern adaptation, cutting, assembly and finishing. May work in small studios, owner-operated businesses or specialist alteration enterprises.
Performance expectations	- Produce garments to required fit and finish standards - Accurately interpret client measurements and design requirements - Maintain high-quality construction and seam integrity - Meet agreed production and alteration timelines - Minimise fabric wastage - Maintain safe and organised work practices
Specialisation	- Custom-made garments - Women's wear and occasion wear - Garment alterations and resizing - Restyling and garment reconstruction - Light bridal and formalwear
Application in other TCF sectors	Transferable to apparel manufacturing, costume production, bridal services and small-scale fashion enterprises.

Key tasks	- Consult with clients regarding garment requirements - Take and record body measurements - Adapt or draft simple garment patterns - Cut fabric components accurately - Assemble garments using sewing machinery and hand techniques - Perform fitting adjustments - Press and finish garments to professional standard
Critical work functions	- Maintaining measurement accuracy - Ensuring garment balance and fit - Preserving design intent - Maintaining consistent stitch quality - Managing fabric handling carefully - Meeting agreed delivery timelines - Maintaining safe machinery operation
