Job role	SSGIN05 Materials Handling Operator (Forklift / Front End Loader / Module Feeder)
Job role description	Operates mobile plant and material handling equipment to move, stage and feed cotton modules and processed materials into and through the ginning process. In the Australian cotton ginning sector—characterised by high-volume, seasonal operations—the Materials Handling Operator plays a critical role in maintaining continuous plant throughput. The role ensures timely delivery of cotton modules to feeders and movement of lint, seed and by-products across the site. The operator works closely with ginning operators and supervisors to ensure efficient workflow, safe equipment operation and minimal disruption to production during peak processing periods.
