Job role	SSMTC11 Installation Technician
Job role description	Performs onsite assembly, installation and fitting activities for cut and sewn non-garment textile products and systems within the Textile, Clothing and Footwear (TCF) industry. This role is identified within the Installation and Field Services function of the occupational framework for cut and sewn products. The Installation Technician supports the installation and servicing of specialised textile and fabricated systems including shade sails, PVC curtains, truck tarps, industrial canvas products, architectural textiles, transport interiors, tensile structures, upholstery systems, protective covers, marine products and technical textile assemblies. The role combines technical textile knowledge with practical installation and assembly capability to ensure fabricated products are correctly fitted, tensioned, aligned and secured onsite in accordance with technical specifications, safety requirements and customer expectations. The Installation Technician works with a range of fabricated textile materials, hardware systems, attachment systems, rigging components and installation equipment. The role requires detailed understanding of textile behaviour, seam integrity, structural attachment methods, tensioning systems, dimensional tolerances and installation sequencing. The position works closely with installation supervisors, fabrication teams, project managers, quality personnel and clients to ensure installations are completed safely, efficiently and to specification. The role also supports troubleshooting, adjustments, maintenance activities and onsite quality verification.

Critical work functions	- Ensuring installations meet technical, structural and operational requirements - Maintaining integrity and functionality of textile systems during installation - Preventing installation errors, product damage and operational delays - Supporting safe work practices and compliance with WHS requirements - Maintaining alignment between fabricated products and onsite installation conditions - Supporting efficient workflow and coordination across installation activities - Maintaining documentation and traceability accuracy - Contributing to customer satisfaction and operational reliability
