Job role	SSDCL3 Pressing / Finishing Technician
Job role description	Performs garment finishing processes including pressing, steaming and shaping to restore garment form and ensure high-quality presentation prior to customer delivery. In the Australian dry cleaning industry—where operations must comply with workplace health, safety and equipment requirements—the Pressing / Finishing Technician applies knowledge of fabric behaviour, heat and steam application to maintain garment integrity while supporting production efficiency and customer satisfaction.
Performance expectations	• Operating pressing and finishing equipment to achieve required garment presentation standards • Applying appropriate heat, steam and pressure based on fabric type and garment construction • Restoring garment shape, structure and appearance during finishing processes • Maintaining garment quality and preventing damage such as scorching or distortion • Ensuring compliance with workplace health, safety and equipment operation procedures • Meeting production targets and workflow requirements • Maintaining accurate garment handling and tracking throughout finishing stages • Coordinating with cleaning and inspection teams to ensure quality outcomes • Maintaining cleanliness and organisation of finishing work areas • Contributing to continuous improvement in finishing quality and productivity

Key tasks	• Inspecting garments to determine finishing requirements • Selecting appropriate pressing techniques based on fabric and garment type • Operating presses, irons and finishing equipment • Applying steam and pressure to remove wrinkles and shape garments • Handling garments carefully to prevent damage during finishing • Preparing garments for packaging and delivery • Maintaining finishing equipment and workstations • Following workplace health, safety and equipment procedures
Critical work functions	• Maintaining garment presentation and quality standards • Applying correct temperature and pressure settings to avoid damage • Ensuring consistent finishing outcomes across garment types • Managing workflow to meet production timelines • Ensuring safe operation of equipment • Coordinating with production and inspection teams

Pressing techniques	Applying heat, steam and pressure to achieve garment finish and shape
Equipment operation	Operating presses, irons and finishing equipment safely
Fabric handling	Handling different fabrics appropriately during finishing
Steam application	Using steam effectively to remove wrinkles and shape garments
Garment shaping	Restoring garment form and structure during finishing processes
Temperature control	Adjusting heat settings based on fabric requirements
Quality control	Inspecting finished garments to ensure presentation standards
