Job role description	Supports garment processing operations across sorting, cleaning preparation, machine loading/unloading and workflow coordination to ensure efficient production flow and consistent quality outcomes. In the Australian dry cleaning industry—where operations must comply with workplace health, safety and environmental requirements—the Production Assistant performs multi-skilled tasks across production stages, assisting cleaning, spotting and finishing teams while maintaining accurate garment handling and workflow efficiency.

Critical work functions	• Maintaining accurate garment identification and tracking throughout production • Supporting efficient workflow between production stages • Handling garments carefully to prevent damage • Ensuring compliance with safety and operational procedures • Meeting production timelines and operational targets • Coordinating effectively with production team members
