1. Job role

TCF sub-sector	Footwear Production
Functional area	Industrial [machine based] production
Job role	SSFOT10 Footwear Machine Operator (Lasting and Assembly)
Job role description	Operates lasting and assembly machinery to shape footwear uppers over lasts and attach soles in accordance with technical specifications. Ensures correct fit, alignment, bonding and structural integrity prior to finishing and quality inspection.
Performance expectations	- Achieve daily lasting and assembly output targets - Ensure correct fit and shape of lasted footwear - Maintain bonding strength and sole alignment - Minimise rework and defects - Operate machinery safely and efficiently - Maintain accurate production records
Specialisation	- Toe and heel lasting operations - Cemented and direct-attach sole assembly - Heat activation and bonding systems
Application in other Textile, Clothing and Footwear (TCF) sectors	Transferable to assembly and forming roles in leather goods, safety footwear and technical product manufacturing sectors.

2. Key tasks and critical work functions

Key tasks	- Set up and operate lasting machines - Position uppers accurately on lasts - Operate sole pressing and bonding equipment - Apply adhesives and heat activation processes - Inspect alignment and bonding integrity - Adjust machine settings for different materials - Record output and report defects
Critical work functions	- Maintaining accurate shaping and fit - Ensuring sole attachment strength and alignment - Supporting workflow continuity to finishing stage - Reducing rework and material waste - Ensuring compliance with safety procedures - Identifying bonding or structural defects early - Maintaining consistent production standards

Lasting machine operation	Operate toe, side and heel lasting equipment.
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Sole attachment processes	Apply cemented, stitched or direct-attach methods.
Adhesive application	Prepare and apply adhesives correctly for bonding strength.
Heat activation systems*	Operate heat-setting and bonding equipment.
Fit and alignment assessment	Check shape, tension and structural integrity.
Basic machine maintenance	Perform routine equipment checks and adjustments.
Digital production tracking*	Record production data in ERP systems.
WHS compliance	Follow safe handling procedures for adhesives and machinery.
