Job role	SSFOT11 Footwear Production Assistant
Job role description	Provides operational support across footwear production stages including component preparation, machine feeding, assembly assistance, finishing support and packing. Works under supervision to maintain workflow efficiency, product quality and safe workplace practices.
Performance expectations	• Support production teams to meet output targets • Maintain quality standards in assigned tasks • Follow safe operating procedures • Ensure accurate preparation and packing of products • Maintain organised and efficient work areas • Assist in reducing material waste and rework
Specialisation	• Component preparation and sorting • Machine feeding and workflow support • Packing and dispatch preparation
Application in other Textile, Clothing and Footwear (TCF) sectors	Transferable to production assistant roles in leather goods, apparel and textile manufacturing sectors.

2. Key tasks and critical work functions

Key tasks	• Prepare and sort components for production • Feed materials into machines under supervision • Assist operators during cutting, closing and assembly • Support finishing and cleaning tasks • Pack footwear according to brand standards • Label and prepare goods for dispatch • Maintain cleanliness and organisation of work areas
Critical work functions	• Maintaining smooth workflow between production stages • Ensuring correct component preparation and allocation • Supporting machine operators efficiently • Maintaining presentation standards for finished goods • Reducing risk of damage during handling and packing • Adhering to workplace health and safety requirements • Maintaining accurate production and packing records

Component preparation	Sort, bundle and stage materials for production.
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Machine feeding support	Assist with loading and unloading materials.
Basic assembly support	Support operators with manual tasks.
Packing procedures	Prepare products for storage or dispatch.
Material handling	Handle leather and synthetic materials safely.
Basic quality awareness	Identify obvious defects before next production stage.
Digital production tracking*	Enter or record simple production data.
WHS compliance	Follow safety procedures for tools and materials.
