Job role	SSFOT12 Material Technologist
Job role description	Evaluates, selects and tests materials used in footwear production including leathers, synthetics, textiles, adhesives and components. Ensures materials meet performance, quality, durability, sustainability and compliance standards in alignment with product specifications.
Performance expectations	- Ensure materials meet technical and performance specifications - Validate durability, safety and compliance standards - Support innovation in material selection - Minimise material-related defects in production - Contribute to sustainability and waste reduction goals - Provide technical advice to design and production teams
Specialisation	- Leather and upper material performance testing - Adhesive and bonding technologies - Sustainable and alternative material development
Application in other Textile, Clothing and Footwear (TCF) sectors	Transferable to leather goods, apparel textiles and advanced material development roles.
