Job role	SSFOT18 Shoe and Boot Maker
Job role description	A trade-qualified craftsman, typically apprenticeship-trained, who designs, constructs, assembles and finishes bespoke and small-batch footwear. Responsible for full footwear construction from pattern interpretation through to finishing, and may provide specialist footwear repair and restoration services.
Performance expectations	- Maintain high standards of craftsmanship and structural integrity - Produce bespoke or small-batch footwear to precise specifications - Ensure correct fit, balance and comfort - Preserve brand and heritage production standards - Deliver repair and restoration work to professional standard - Meet agreed production or client timelines
Specialisation	- Bespoke and made-to-measure footwear - Traditional hand-welted or stitched construction - Specialist footwear repair and restoration
Application in other Textile, Clothing and Footwear (TCF) sectors	Transferable to artisanal leather goods production, saddlery, costume footwear and specialist restoration services.

2. Key tasks and critical work functions

Key tasks	- Interpret bespoke designs and client specifications - Develop and adapt patterns for custom fit - Cut, close, last and assemble footwear components - Perform hand-stitching and traditional construction methods - Attach soles using welted, stitched or cemented techniques - Conduct finishing, polishing and presentation preparation - Undertake footwear repairs and structural restorations
Critical work functions	- Maintaining structural integrity and durability - Ensuring correct fit and ergonomic performance - Preserving traditional craftsmanship standards - Adapting construction techniques to material variations - Identifying repair and restoration requirements - Maintaining precise measurement and pattern accuracy - Supporting client satisfaction and brand reputation

Pattern development and adaptation	Modify and draft patterns for bespoke fit.
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Hand cutting and assembly	Use traditional tools for precise material preparation.
Upper construction techniques	Perform complex stitching and reinforcement methods.
Lasting and shaping	Shape footwear accurately over lasts.
Sole construction methods	Apply welted, stitched and cemented techniques.
Repair and restoration techniques	Replace soles, heels and structural components.
Material knowledge	Assess leather grades, stretch and durability characteristics.
Tool and equipment maintenance	Maintain cutting tools and craft equipment.
