Job role	SSLPR10 Effluent Treatment Plant (ETP) Operator
Job role description	Operates and maintains the effluent treatment plant within a leather production facility to ensure wastewater is treated in accordance with environmental licence conditions and regulatory standards. Monitors chemical dosing, biological treatment processes, sludge handling and discharge quality. Works closely with Environmental Monitoring Technicians and production teams to manage tannery effluent loads.
Performance expectations	• Operate primary, secondary and tertiary wastewater treatment systems • Monitor pH, chromium levels, BOD, COD and suspended solids • Adjust chemical dosing and aeration systems to maintain compliance • Maintain sludge dewatering and disposal processes • Record operational data accurately and consistently • Identify plant faults and escalate maintenance requirements • Ensure compliance with EPA discharge licence limits
Specialisation	May specialise in chrome recovery systems, biological treatment optimisation, membrane filtration, sludge management or recycled water systems within tannery operations.
Application in other TCF sectors	Transferable to wastewater treatment roles in textile dyeing and finishing plants, industrial laundries, food processing facilities and other water-intensive manufacturing environments.

2. Key tasks and critical work functions

Key tasks	• Monitor influent and effluent flows and treatment parameters • Operate screening, equalisation and clarification systems • Control chemical dosing systems for pH correction and chrome precipitation • Operate aeration tanks and biological treatment processes • Manage sludge thickening, dewatering and disposal • Conduct routine water quality testing • Maintain plant equipment and perform minor maintenance • Respond to alarms and abnormal discharge events
Critical work functions	• Prevention of non-compliant discharge to sewer or environment

	• Stabilisation of effluent load variations from wet-end operations • Accurate and timely adjustment of treatment parameters • Protection of surrounding environment and community health • Reliable operation of plant equipment to avoid system failure

Wastewater treatment processes	Understand primary, biological and chemical treatment systems.
Chemical dosing control	Adjust lime, acid and coagulant dosing systems.
Water quality testing	Test pH, COD, BOD, chromium and suspended solids.
Chrome recovery systems	Operate precipitation and recovery systems.
Sludge management	Manage thickening, dewatering and disposal processes.
Equipment operation	Operate pumps, aerators, clarifiers and control panels.
Operational data recording	Maintain accurate plant logs and compliance records.

Communication	Report operational status to supervisors and environmental staff.
