Job role description	Assesses and fits saddles to horses and riders to ensure correct balance, comfort and performance. Works with saddlers and production teams to adjust saddles and provide expert advice on fit, flocking, structural alignment and suitability.

Fit assessment techniques	Evaluate balance, clearance and pressure distribution.

Flocking adjustment awareness	Identify when reflocking is required.
Customer consultation	Conduct structured fitting consultations.
Documentation	Record fitting assessments and recommendations.
Safety protocols	Apply safe handling practices around horses.
