1. Job role

Job role	SSNST07 Textile Finishing Operator
Job role description	Operates and supports textile finishing machinery and processes used to enhance the appearance, functionality, durability and performance characteristics of textile materials within the natural and synthetic textiles sector of the Textile, Clothing and Footwear (TCF) industry. This role is identified within the Technical Textile Production function of the Natural and Synthetic Textile Manufacturing Occupational Framework as an emerging occupation. The Textile Finishing Operator is responsible for carrying out textile finishing operations that transform raw or partially processed fabrics into finished materials suitable for commercial, industrial and technical applications. The role supports finishing operations across a broad range of textile products including apparel textiles, furnishing fabrics, industrial textiles, technical textiles, filtration systems, transport textiles, protective materials, medical textiles and advanced engineered textile systems. The Textile Finishing Operator works with natural fibres such as wool and cotton and synthetic materials including polyester, nylon, acrylic, polypropylene and blended technical fibres. The role requires operation of specialised textile finishing systems including washing, drying, heat setting, calendaring, coating preparation, chemical finishing, flame-retardant treatment, water-repellent finishing, antimicrobial treatment and surface enhancement processes. The position requires detailed understanding of textile behaviour, fabric construction, finishing chemistry, machine setup, process control, curing conditions, tension management and quality requirements. Operators monitor finishing consistency, dimensional stability, colour performance, handle, appearance and technical functionality to ensure products meet customer and technical specifications. The Textile Finishing Operator works closely with textile technologists, production supervisors, maintenance technicians, quality personnel and process specialists to maintain operational efficiency, minimise defects and support continuous improvement across textile finishing operations.

	The role also contributes to sustainability initiatives, water and energy reduction practices, process optimisation, troubleshooting and advanced textile manufacturing capability development.
Performance expectations	- Producing finished textile materials that meet technical, functional and aesthetic specifications - Operating textile finishing machinery safely and efficiently - Maintaining consistency of textile appearance, handle and performance characteristics - Minimising finishing defects, contamination and process waste - Supporting effective machine setup, calibration and process control - Monitoring curing, drying and finishing performance throughout production - Supporting compliance with safety, environmental and quality procedures - Maintaining traceability and production documentation - Contributing to productivity, sustainability and continuous improvement initiatives

2. Key tasks and critical work functions

Key tasks	- Operating textile washing, drying, heat setting and finishing machinery - Preparing fabrics, chemicals and finishing materials for processing - Monitoring temperatures, curing conditions, line speeds and process parameters - Applying specialised finishing treatments including water repellency, flame retardancy and antimicrobial finishes - Conducting visual and technical inspections of finished textile materials - Identifying finishing defects, contamination and process inconsistencies - Adjusting machine settings to maintain finishing quality and production efficiency - Performing routine cleaning, calibration and basic maintenance activities - Recording production, quality and traceability information - Following workplace safety, environmental and operational procedures
Critical work functions	- Ensuring finished textiles meet technical, functional and appearance specifications - Maintaining dimensional stability, fabric integrity and finishing consistency - Preventing finishing defects, contamination and process failures
