Job role	CS07 Manager – Risk, Compliance and Sustainability
Job role description	Leads the development and oversight of risk management, regulatory compliance and ethical sourcing frameworks within a textile, clothing or footwear enterprise. The role ensures the organisation complies with workplace health and safety, trade regulations, environmental requirements and responsible sourcing standards that apply to domestic operations and global supply chains. In the Australian TCF industry—where many businesses source materials and manufacture products internationally—the Director – Risk and Compliance monitors supplier practices, supply chain transparency and regulatory obligations. The role works closely with executive leadership, supply chain, operations and finance teams to manage organisational risk, maintain compliance systems and strengthen corporate governance.

	operate complex supply chains, product development cycles and market-driven production systems.

Critical work functions	• Identification and mitigation of enterprise and supply chain risks • Maintenance of corporate governance and compliance systems • Monitoring of responsible sourcing and supplier compliance • Alignment of risk management with operational and commercial decision making • Protection of organisational reputation and regulatory standing
