Job role description	Operates 3D printing and rapid prototyping systems to produce components, samples and product prototypes for TCF applications. The role supports product development by translating digital designs into physical prototypes, enabling testing, fit validation and design iteration. It works closely with design, pattern making and engineering functions to support innovation, customisation and reduced development timelines.
