Job role	SSWOL03 Carding / Combing Technician
Job role description	Operates and monitors carding and combing equipment to align, clean and prepare scoured wool fibres for downstream processing such as spinning or further textile manufacturing. In the Australian wool scouring sector—characterised by high mechanisation and integrated processing—the Carding / Combing Technician plays a critical role in fibre preparation. The role ensures fibres are disentangled, aligned and refined to meet quality and processing requirements. The technician works closely with scouring operations, quality and maintenance teams to maintain fibre consistency, optimise machine performance and support continuous production flow.
Performance expectations	- Producing fibre sliver that meets alignment and cleanliness specifications - Maintaining stable carding and combing process conditions - Operating machinery safely and efficiently - Minimising fibre loss, neps and defects - Monitoring equipment performance and responding to issues - Maintaining continuous production flow - Recording production and quality data accurately - Following WHS and operational procedures
