Job role	SSWOL04 Materials Handling Operator
Job role description	Manages the movement, storage and handling of raw wool, processed fibre and by-products within wool scouring operations to support continuous production flow. In the Australian wool scouring sector—characterised by high mechanisation and streamlined operations—the Materials Handling Operator plays a critical role in ensuring that materials are delivered to and removed from processing stages efficiently and safely. The role supports plant operators by maintaining uninterrupted material flow across scouring, drying and fibre preparation stages. The operator works closely with production, logistics and maintenance teams to ensure correct handling, storage and traceability of materials in a fast-paced industrial environment.
Performance expectations	- Ensuring continuous supply of raw wool to processing lines - Safely handling and transporting materials and fibre products - Maintaining accurate stock control and traceability - Minimising material loss, contamination and damage - Operating handling equipment efficiently and safely - Supporting production flow and plant efficiency - Maintaining clean and organised storage areas - Following WHS and operational procedures
