Job role	SSWOL05 Wool Presser / Baler
Job role description	Compresses, packs and prepares scoured and processed wool into bales for storage, transport and sale, ensuring correct weight, density and labelling. In the Australian wool scouring sector—characterised by high mechanisation and export-oriented production—the Wool Presser / Baler plays a critical role in preparing fibre for downstream logistics and market distribution. The role ensures that processed wool is compacted efficiently and meets industry and customer specifications. The operator works closely with production, quality and logistics functions to ensure bale integrity, traceability and compliance with handling and export requirements.
Performance expectations	- Producing bales that meet weight, density and quality specifications - Operating pressing and baling equipment safely and efficiently - Ensuring correct labelling and traceability of bales - Minimising fibre loss and contamination during handling - Maintaining consistent bale quality and presentation - Supporting efficient storage and transport processes - Recording production and bale data accurately - Following WHS and operational procedures
