Job role	SSWOL06 Chemical Process Operator
Job role description	Operates and monitors chemical dosing, treatment and recovery systems within wool scouring operations to ensure effective cleaning, grease removal and environmental compliance. In the Australian wool scouring sector—characterised by high mechanisation and environmentally regulated processes—the Chemical Process Operator manages the use of detergents, alkalis and other chemicals used in scouring, as well as supporting grease recovery and effluent treatment processes. The role is emerging due to increasing environmental regulation and process optimisation requirements, and involves close coordination with plant operators, maintenance teams and environmental compliance functions to ensure safe, efficient and compliant operations.
