Job role	SSWOL08 Yard Hand / Cleaner
Job role description	Maintains cleanliness, order and basic operational support across wool scouring facilities, including yards, plant areas and storage zones. In the Australian wool scouring sector—characterised by high mechanisation and lean operational structures—the Yard Hand / Cleaner plays a fundamental support role in ensuring safe, efficient and hygienic working environments. The role supports production continuity by maintaining clear workspaces and assisting with basic tasks. The position works across multiple areas of the site, supporting production, maintenance and logistics teams in maintaining operational readiness and compliance with safety and environmental requirements.
